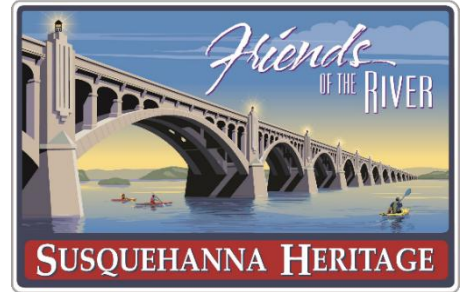

Dear NAME,

In the last two years, over 600 4th and 5th graders got out-of-doors, in a creek, and on the river. But we didn't do it alone. Because of donors like *you*, we could partner with the National Park Service Every Kid in a Park Program and get kids, and their families, into parks at the river.

It's because of donors like you, kids walk on the Susquehannock Indian paths; find fish, crayfish and bugs in a creek; sit in a dugout canoe; and discover the river through art.
